



DONATING STOCKS, SECURITIES & OTHER GIFTS

Church of the Foothills welcomes gifts of cash, stock, materials, equipment or property of any kind, which promote the mission of Church of the Foothills.

Guidelines

Monetary Gifts: Church of the Foothills welcomes unrestricted gifts of cash or stock or, if restricted, gifts of cash or stocks that would support the mission of Church of the Foothills.

Real Estate or other Personal Property: Church of the Foothills accepts unrestricted gifts of real property that either support or could be sold to support the mission of Church of the Foothills.

Bequests: Bequests that are unrestricted in purpose, or, if restricted, support the mission of Church of the Foothills, will be gratefully accepted.

Legacy Giving: For information on other gifting opportunities, such as planned giving documents, e.g. life insurance policies, charitable lead trusts, charitable remainder trusts, life income gifts, etc., the Christian and Missionary Alliance has individuals who can assist you with your desire to support the work of Church of the Foothills with your legacy gifts.

Valuation: Church of the Foothills will provide a timely, written acknowledgment of the receipt of gifts to the donor and, if desired, to a DONATING STOCKS, SECURITIES & OTHER GIFTS recognized individual or organization. Income tax regulations leave the determination of the gift's monetary value to the donor. Donors wishing to have an appraisal of their gifts done for income tax purposes should do so prior to donation.

Church of the Foothills truly appreciates any and all gifts, but reserves the right to refuse any gift that the Leadership Board, in its sole discretion, deems to be not in the best interest of Church of the Foothills and its Mission.

The accepted gift to Church of the Foothills shall be final and without any restrictions on the Church of the Foothill's ownership, possession, use or disposition of the gift.
